Measure V New Construction Projects

The 2004 construction of performing arts auditoriums at both West Ranch and Golden Valley High Schools included only the basic exterior shells. Construction of interior improvements began in June 2009 and will be completed in early October 2009. When completed, these auditoriums will provide students with an instructional space and performing arts venue that will contain state-of-the-art

staging, sound, and lighting equipment. State Proposition 1D funds will augment Measure V funds and will provide facility enhancements that will make both of these facilities among the best at any high school.

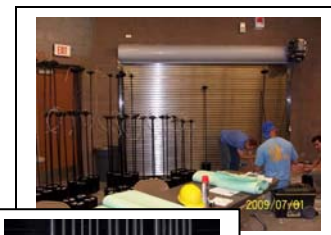
