Attention Parents!

Do you have kids who ride Santa Clarita Transit? Good news! The City of Santa Clarita Transit has upgraded to TAP (Transit Access Pass), Los Angeles County's new bus fare payment card. This card will replace paper passes and free students from hauling around exact change.

You can load your student's TAP card with cash fare or a monthly pass, therefore eliminating the need to give them cash. Additionally, the TAP card is secure and can be replaced if lost or stolen. Traditional paper passes were not refundable misplaced but the TAP card offers parents a new option if the card is lost or stolen. Make sure to sign up for the free Balance Protection and the card will be registered to your student.



Why the move to TAP?

TAP is a durable plastic card that contains a smart chip which deducts the exact bus fare amount each time you ride and remembers your account balance to the penny. Not only does TAP work on all City of Santa Clarita Transit local and commuter routes, but also on all METRO bus and rail lines, making it easier than ever to connect with destinations outside of Santa Clarita. With TAP, you literally "tap" the farebox with your card when it's time to ride. If your account balance is low, replenish your permanent card by adding value to it.



Here's how it works:

Using TAP couldn't be easier. When boarding a City of Santa Clarita Transit bus, simply tap your card on the farebox located at the entrance. Listen for the beep and look for the message on the farebox's display screen confirming your card's validity. If the fare isn't covered as part of a monthly pass, the smart chip inside your TAP card will make sure that only the exact cash fare is deducted from your account balance.



TAP to Go.

Eventually, TAP will be available on various other transit agency buses in Los Angeles County.
